

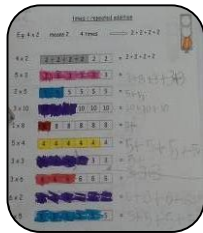
# Traffic Light System

Our traffic light system allows pupils to communicate their understanding of the task.

**Red:** Pupil required lots of help

**Amber:** Pupil required a little bit of help

**Green:** Pupil understood the task and was able to complete it independently



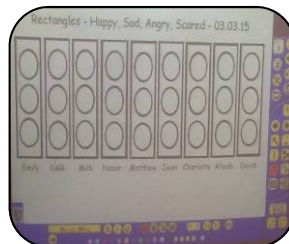
*Pupil completing traffic light system on their own work*



Pupils may share this information during circle times or on a one to one basis with teachers and support staff.



80% of our children who were able to respond said that they understood and liked the system!

At Ysgol Pen Coch we use three main methods of involving our pupils in assessment for learning:

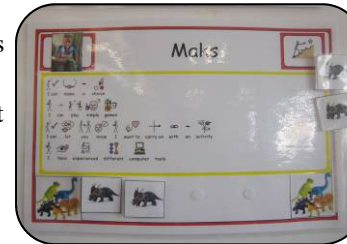
1. Annual Target Reward Charts

## Annual Target Reward Charts

Our TA3 work with pupils to produce the targets in a more child friendly format



These targets are shared with pupils with the support of symbols using the familiar program 'Communicate in Print'



Where possible pupils take an active part by placing their reward picture onto the chart once the target is achieved.



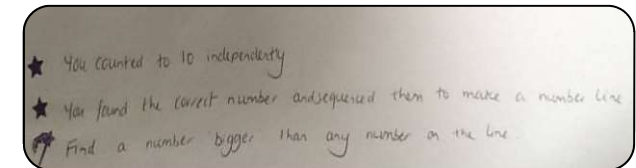
Once a target is achieved the pupil will receive the reward.

## 2 Stars and a Wish

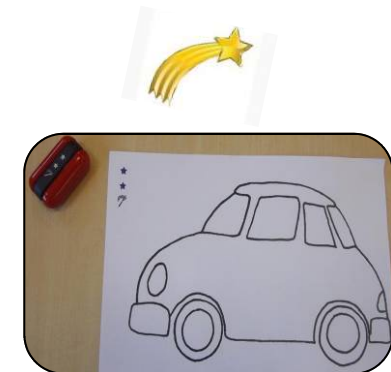


2 Stars and a wish stamp
